
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ILLNESS & ABSENCE

- -are contagious.




- -cover the nose and mouth with arm or elbow when coughing or sneezing

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VPK LEARNING GOALS IN SEPTEMBER

We spent the first couple of weeks getting to know the teachers, classmates, and the routine. We talked about creation and about how God created each of us so uniquely...and yet so alike!

Looking ahead, we're going to dig into:

*our favorite things;

*working and playing together - even when we have different interests and personalities;

*exploring the world around us in nature;

*the helpers he gives us in the church;

*our families and the responsibilities each family member has to help out at home.

In Bible time, we'll hear about God's plan for salvation after Adam & Eve sinned, and how God is ALWAYS faithful to his promises!

One-on-one VPK assessments will also be taking place in the next couple of weeks. These literacy assessments help to gauge a starting point for your child's academic development in VPK.

LEARNING & DEVELOPING IN THE THREES

One week in, and the threes are off to a great start! Getting the hang of the routine is always a big step for this age group. Once they trust that play time is really coming, they're ready to follow along with all of the other plans. ③

Coming up, we'll be doing activities that promote:

*learning about our bodies - how God designed them, how they work, how we take care of them, and the people that take care of us when we are sick or injured;

*recognizing "same" & "different" and sorting objects into sets:

*fine motor development to build up our muscles (for later writing, drawing, etc.);

*gross motor development to build our core and be aware of our space:

*using our voice in various ways - speaking, whispering, shouting, singing, loudly & softly; *remembering God's faithful promise to save us all after Adam and Eve sinned.
